


## Rules for the factory tour

Please stay with your group at all times during the plant tour. Always follow the instructions of the tour guide. The tour guide is authorized to exclude individuals from the tour in case of rule violations.

-  Persons with pacemakers and pregnant women are not permitted to participate in plant tours.
-  Wear sturdy, closed-toe shoes (no sandals, high heels, flip-flops, etc.).
-  Wear long, sturdy clothing (long sleeves and long pants) for the mill tour. No liability is accepted for soiling or damage to your clothing.
-  Wearing the protective equipment provided is mandatory throughout the entire mill tour.
-  The tour guide will instruct you to wear hearing protection as necessary.
-  Smoking is only permitted outdoors.
-  For safety reasons, mobile phones may not be used during the factory tour.
-  Photographing and filming our factory facilities is prohibited.
-  Never stand under suspended loads.
-  Do not touch any material surfaces. There is a risk of burns.
-  Dispose of waste properly.
-  For your own safety, use the handrail when climbing stairs.

# Welcome to Steeltec

## We warmly welcome you at our site

Safety is a high priority for us. Please read the provided safety instructions and follow them during your visit.

### Registration of trucks

- We ask all truck drivers to register at the Steeltec AG/Logistics reception desk, unless you have received other instructions.
- Access to the mill premises is only possible via the main entrance, unless other instructions are given.

### Visitors

- The meeting point for plant tours is the Steeltec Center.
- All other visitors must report to the Steeltec AG reception desk and ask for their internal contact person, or your contact person will pick you up at the previously agreed meeting point.

### Traffic on the factory premises

- The traffic regulations apply on the company premises.
- The speed limit is 30 km/h.
- Plant traffic always has the right of way. (railway, forklifts, special vehicles).
- Please use only designated parking spaces and walkways.

## What to do in an emergency

- Stay calm
- Your contact person will inform you about what to do in an emergency.



In the event of an evacuation, proceed to the nearest assembly point.



Inside buildings, please follow the marked escape routes.
